## **AAGO Announces Series of Changes for Parking Patrons at UM Football Games**

### **Prices Remain the Same Patrons to be Directed to Parking Spots**

Ann Arbor, Michigan –For 25 years Ann Arbor Golf and Outing has allowed UM football fans to park on its fairways for home football games. Recent changes have been made in order to provide a safer parking environment for patrons.

“We have made several changes to better insure safety, which is our top priority when we allow patrons to park at our club,” said Larry T. Eiler, parking chairman of the 118-year-old club located directly across Stadium Blvd from UM’s “Big House” football stadium.

Eiler said, “For the fifth consecutive year parking costs will be \$40 per vehicle. There will be no extra charges for canopies as long as they are parked in the correct spots, adjacent to the front or rear of vehicle.”

Changes are:

1. The maximum size for a canopy is 10 by 12 feet, and for safety reasons cannot occupy the traffic lanes or be placed on the side of a vehicle.
2. Parking supervisors will direct as to where the vehicles must be parked. Only one section will be opened at a time and the next will not be opened until the previous area is full. There will no longer be group parking at a favorite spot due to restrictions in traffic flow and safety concerns.
3. Off-duty sheriffs will work with parking supervisors to insure proper parking of vehicles. Patrons who do not follow directions will be moved or removed from the premises.
4. Members of AAGO and handicapped patrons will be allowed to park in the paved lots and the section of fairway to the left of the Stadium Blvd entry.
5. People gathering bottles and cans will no longer be allowed on the course without proper authorization.
